I have been with Hoffman Construction over 26 years, and have been performing alternative public works contracting in the state of Washington for the last 20 years. My experience with alternative delivery includes over a dozen projects utilizing GC/CM, Heavy Civil GC/CM, Design Build and Progressive Design/Build with a variety of public owners. These projects (which total over \$2 Billion) have demonstrated to me that the alternative delivery process when utilized properly, has the ability to positively impact the delivery of public projects.

My experience on these alternative delivery projects has included all aspects of the construction process, from Preconstruction through Commissioning. As a Project Manager at the Brightwater Treatment Plant and Sound Transit UW Station project, I was able to help King County and Sound Transit, successfully navigate the GC/CM process their first GC/CM projects. I have also been involved with Heavy Civil GC/CM projects with Sound Transit and Design-Build projects with the University of Washington and Washington State University. These experiences have shown how collaboration between the Contractor, Owner and the Design team is critical to overcoming the increasing challenges and complexity facing all projects today.

In addition to my project experience, I have also been active in groups that are helping to improve the construction industry. I am a certified DBIA professional. I have participated in the CPARB GC/CM reauthorization committee as well as the GC/CM and MCCM/ECCM best practices committee. I have also been active in workforce development for the construction industry and am part of the King County Priority Hire Advisory Committee. In addition, I sit on the board of Safebuild Alliance of Washington, a group dedicated to improving safety in our industry.

I believe that I can be a strong asset to the Project Review Committee, and can leverage my experiences to help ensure that alternative delivery projects continue to be successful. I would welcome the opportunity to continue as member of PRC and contribute to the alternative project delivery process in this State.
