

AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the State of Washington, Department of General Administration, has authority to promulgate rules and regulations for the control of vehicular and pedestrian traffic and the parking of motor vehicles on the State Capitol grounds pursuant to RCW 46.08.150; and

WHEREAS, the City of Olympia has jurisdiction to enact ordinances regulating the parking of motor vehicles on City owned streets within the City of Olympia; and

WHEREAS, there is some uncertainty under state law as to the precise geographical limits of the jurisdiction of the respective parties; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into this agreement outlining their respective responsibilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed as follows:

(1) The areas of responsibility and jurisdiction for motor vehicle parking enforcement shall be as outlined on the attached map, labeled Exhibit 1, and included by reference in this agreement. Streets outlined in blue on Exhibit 1 shall be under the jurisdiction of the State of Washington; streets outlined in yellow on Exhibit 1 shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the City of Olympia.

(2) Each party has the authority to enact parking regulations within their area of jurisdiction as outlined on Exhibit 1 and to erect traffic control devices necessary to enforce said regulations.

(3) To the extent necessary to accomplish this purpose, each party constitutes the other as its agent for the purpose of vehicle parking and enforcement of same.

(4) The proceeds collected from enforcement activities shall be disposed of in accordance with each respective jurisdiction's current practices.

(5) Each party agrees to consult with the other in establishing parking regulations in the areas adjacent to and on the capitol campus, so as to minimize public inconvenience, and to assure a continued free flow of traffic throughout the area.

(6) This agreement may be cancelled by either party upon the giving of ninety (90) days notice.

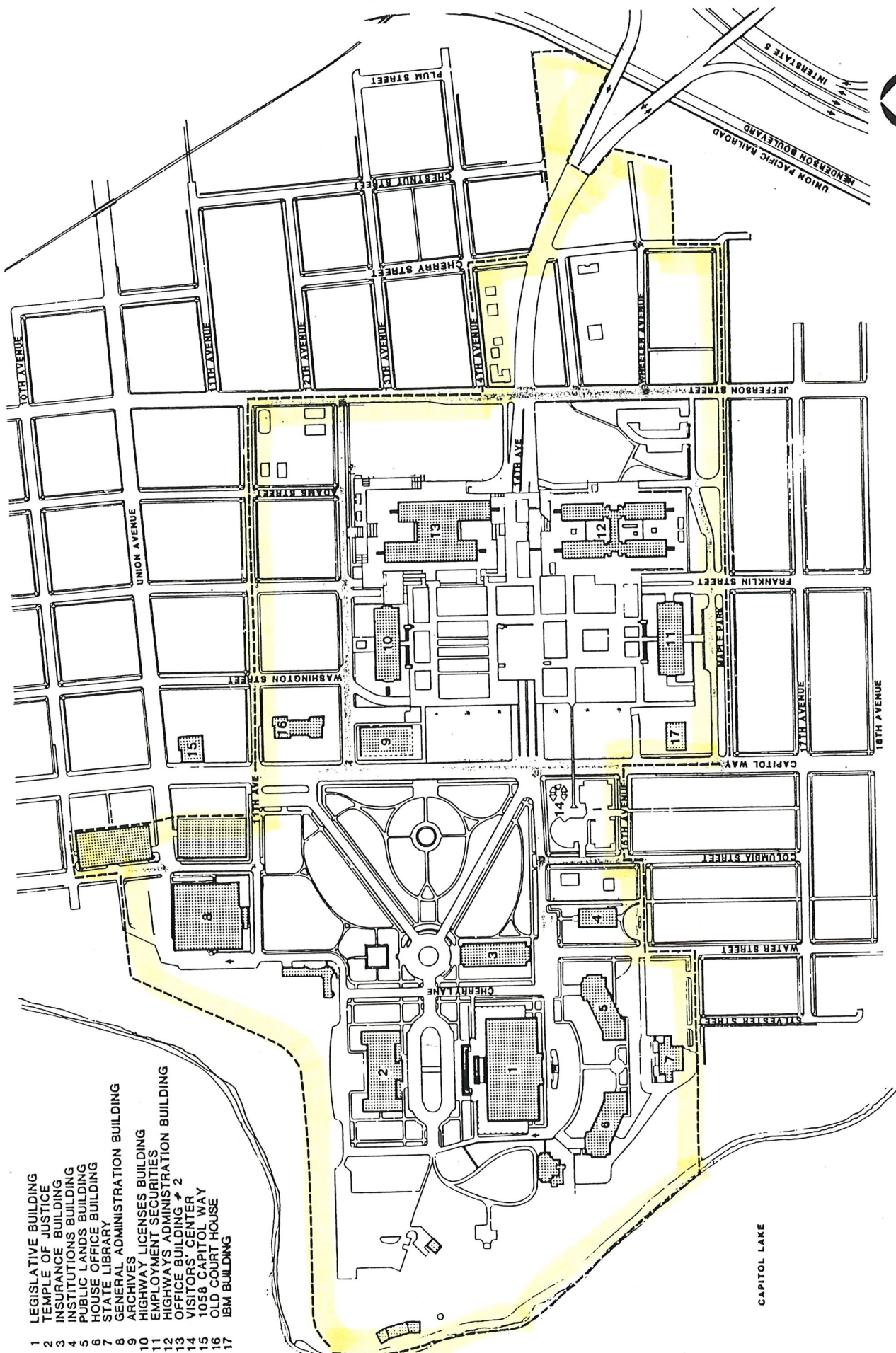
