





- Design Build Delivery: Civil + Systems
- Contract Value: \$730M
- Contract Start: September 2019
- Revenue Service Window: Spring 2025
- AHJ's: WSDOT, City of Redmond, King County (Parks and Wastewater)
- Stakeholders: Microsoft, residents and downtown businesses


