

Workshop summary – Local jurisdictions

Meeting date: Thursday, Dec. 19, 9 to 11 a.m.

Location: Lacey City Hall

DES provided an update on the rulemaking process, shared a rulemaking process map, and shared that concepts for future phases on the process map will be influenced by what DES hears at initial workshops and may be updated.

DES asked local jurisdictions what is important to them. Group discussed:

- The importance of knowing what an implementation plan would look like before a rule is adopted.
- Ideas on how DES can take a regional approach that involves working with partners, including nearby jurisdictions.
- Environmental issues related to sewage dumping.
- The desire for DES to participate as overall solutions regarding homelessness issues as they are developed in Thurston County.

DES asked advice in moving forward with rulemaking process. Group discussed:

- Suggestions for groups DES should engage with, and advice on how to best engage with them.
- Information DES should examine such as parking ordinances in nearby jurisdictions and developing case law that DES should explore.
