STATE EMPLOYEE PARKING GUIDE

GENERAL INFORMATION

- State employee parking is by permit only and paid by payroll deduction.
- Registered carpool and vanpools can park for free.
- Rideshare employees (two people) must register with Parking Services. Each employee pays half the parking fee.
- If you are parking in an unregistered vehicle, contact Parking Services no later than 8:30 a.m. or you may be ticketed.

PARKING ENFORCEMENT

- Parking enforcement or accident/damage investigations are managed by WSP, 360-596-4555.
- Parking stickers are non-transferable and cannot be moved from car to car.
- Employees assigned to a state facility located on the capitol campus may not park in spaces set aside and marked for visitors, tourists, and other special purposes unless authorized to do so by the director as per WAC 200-200-350.

- Violation may result in a fine, impoundment of vehicle or loss of parking privileges. It is your responsibility to contact Parking Services when your parking status changes.

COMMUTE TRIP OPTIONS

Commuter Trip Reduction saves time and money. It also increases available parking on the Capitol Campus, reduces traffic congestion, and helps to improve air quality.

Commuter options include biking, walking, transit, carpool/vanpool and rideshare. Free or discounted parking is available to employees who share one authorized vehicle to commute to campus.

The state's Commuter Trip Reduction Program also provides:

- STAR Pass (transit)
- Bicycle parking
- Emergency-ride-home program
