**COUNTY SEAT: EVERETT** 

Named for the Snohomish Indian people and for the Snohomish River

Traditional home of Snohomish, Stillaguamish, Skykomish, Sauk-Suiattle, Snoqualmie and Kikiallus American Indian people

Three major rivers — the Snohomish, Skykomish and Stillaguamish — flow through Snohomish County from the slopes of the Cascade Mountains to the shores of Puget Sound. Early county residents were drawn to the region's mining towns, logging camps, sawmills and quarries. Slabs of granite quarried in the Snohomish County town of Index were used for the broad front steps of Washington's state capitol.

SAUK-SUIATTLE, SNOQUALMIE AND KIKIALLUS AMERICAN INDIAN PEOPLE TRADITIONAL HOME OF SNOHOMISH, STILLAGUAMISH, SKYKOMISH,

THROUGH SNOHOMISH COUNTY FROM THE SLOPES OF THE CASCADE MOUNTAINS TO THE SHORES OF PUGET SOUND. EARLY COUNTY RESIDENTS WERE DRAWN TO THE REGION'S THREE MAJOR RIVERS - THE SNOHOMISH, SKYKOMISH AND STILLAGUAMISH - FLOW QUARRIED IN THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY TOWN OF INDEX WERE USED FOR THE BROAD MINING TOWNS, LOGGING CAMPS, SAWMILLS AND QUARRIES. SLABS OF GRANITE FRONT STEPS OF WASHINGTON'S STATE CAPITOL.
