<u>CPARB</u> is a state board created (see <u>RCW 39.10.800</u> and <u>RCW 39.10.810</u>) to provide evaluation of public capital project construction processes including the impact of contracting methods on project outcomes and to advise the legislature on policies related to public works delivery methods. CPARB has created the PRC with members from many different public and private entities with wide variety of backgrounds, expertise and experience.

The PRC was created by the legislature in 2007 to review and approve projects and project teams proposing to use the General Contractor/Construction Manager (GC/CM) and Design Build (DB) contracting methods on projects and project teams and to certify public bodies for three years to use these procedures for projects with a total project cost of \$10 million. The committee also reviews and approves the use of GC/CM procedures by certified public bodies for projects under \$10 million.

CPARB will review letters of interest during its September 2014 meeting and at subsequent meetings until positions are filled.
