At the verbal request of the PRC Chair the Port of Seattle submitted separate applications for GCCM and Design-Build certification rather than a bundled application for both methods. Some previous applicants including the City of Seattle and Department of Enterprise Services have used the combined application.

Port of Seattle, GC/CM Certification

- A quorum of 18 committee members attended.
- Written questions submitted by PRC members prior to the presentation were responded to by the applicant and forwarded to panel members.
- Presentation was chaired by PRC Chair Chandler and application was approved unanimously.

Port of Seattle, Design-Build Certification

- A quorum of 18 committee members attended.
- Written questions submitted by PRC members prior to the presentation were responded to by the applicant and forwarded to panel members.

Legislative Update

CPARB Co-Chair Bob Maruska presented a brief legislative update for PRC members present. Mr. Maruska discussed the legislative process including discussion of recent statute changes recommended by CPARB.

- A panel of 8 members chaired by Member Graybeal denied the application unanimously primarily on the grounds of applicant's inadequately presented management structure.
- The applicant was encouraged to address PRC panel assessments and re-submit in the future.
