SB 5268 Companion HB 1306	Addressing equity and efficiencies in public works procurement including modifying small works roster requirements. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Modifies small works roster requirements to address equity and efficiencies in public works procurement. Updates and revises the small and limited works roster process to increase administrative efficiency. Requires the Office of Minority and Women's Business Enterprises to adopt rules governing a public works small business certification plan. Removes the requirement for the Department of Enterprise Services to survey and which states provide a bidding preference on public works contracts for their resident contractors. Requires the Capital Projects Advisory Review Board (CPARB) to review construction cost escalation data for Washington State. Requires CPARB to make recommendations to the appropriate committees of the Legislature on adjustments to existing contracting thresholds. Requires the Department of Commerce to create a statewide small-works roster by June 30, 2024. Requires the Office of Minority and Women's Business Enterprises to adopt rules governing a public works small business certification program. Requires the Capital Projects Advisory Review Board to periodically review construction cost escalation data, roster utilization, and other appropriate data and metrics, and make recommendations to the Legislature on adjustments to contracting thresholds. Requires the Department of Enterprise Services to develop and make available on its public-facing website templates for bid invitations, bidding, and contracting. HB 1050	Expanding apprenticeship utilization requirements. Expanding apprenticeship utilization requirements; amending RCW 39.04.320; and providing an effective date. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Requires public works contracts awarded by a municipality that cost more than \$1 million to include specifications that no less than 15 percent of the labor hours be performed by apprentices. Requires subcontracts of public works contracts with an initial subcontract price of \$200,000 or more to include specifications that no less than 15 percent of the labor hours be performed by apprentices. Requires municipalities to monitor and report their apprentice utilization hours by contractor and subcontractor. Adds language to ensure public works projects subject to the apprenticeship utilization requirements adhere to said requirements for the one-year period immediately preceding the date of the bid solicitation. Requires bidders who have a demonstrated history of noncompliance with apprenticeship utilization requirements to submit an apprenticeship utilization plan to obtain contracts. Requires all bidders at the time of bid submittal to have at least one designated person trained on public works and wages within the last three years.
