Chair Dobyms gave an over view of the [SBLPE Committee Report](#) to the legislature that was submitted on November 1, 2022.

This meeting was scheduled and posted in response to CPARB member concerns that the Diverse Businesses, Design and Engineering Businesses, and Specialty Subcontractor Businesses wanted an opportunity to provide feedback and discuss the report. Chair Dobyms shared that he had reached out via email to the three Board members who had expressed disappointment their stakeholder groups had not provided input on the Legislative Report and shared when this meeting would take place so they or someone from their respective groups could attend.

No representatives of those stakeholder groups were in attendance. The Committee recommended that Chair Dobyms reach out to those representatives who had expressed concerns and inquire as to the best way to obtain feedback from those stakeholder groups.

Erik McCarley from OMWBE will share this discussion and concerns with the new OMWBE Director to see if she has any input or ideas on how to broaden the search for stakeholder feedback.
