#### Item 1: Members gather

- Call to Order

## Item 2: Meeting topic: Report on CPARB special meeting

Co-chair Yang shared that the draft language prepared by this committee was approved by CPARB at the special November meeting. Work remaining includes adjusting the language into bill form and preparing the fiscal note that will be attached to it. Co-Chair Yang will work with Nancy Deakins, Ann Larsen, Janice Zahn, and Bill Frare to determine next steps—the companion language drafted by the Small Works Committee will hopefully be approved at the December meeting, after which they will need to determine whether to present both issues together or as separate bills. This question was also posed to the group.

• Multiple members felt that keeping the issues separate could make it more likely that one or both bills are passed. The statutes relevant to small works have been controversial in the past, so whatever can be done to keep these issues clear would make their success more likely.

Members discussed the applicability of the new small business definition to different parts of the RCW, and whether it would apply only to alternative public works and the small works roster (39.04, 39.10, 39.19) or also to goods and services (39.26).

- The point was made that if a public agency was to hire a consultant not classified under construction—for instance, environmental, engineering, or architecture—a different definition of small business might apply.
- Members also discussed the difference and crossover between personal services under RCW 39.26 and professional (AE) services under RCW 39.80.
- It was shared that it may not make sense to use employee number maximums to define small business in different contexts than alternative public works/construction. Partly because of the way different NASC codes may apply depending on the situation, it will take more work to determine an appropriate way to apply the new definition of small business to RCW 39.26 and 39.80.
- Multiple members felt that while working on the issue of goods and services would be worthwhile in future, the work done thus far has been in the context of the small works roster and the inclusion plan requirements in RCW 39.10. This is also the context in which CPARB has approved the draft language. Revisiting the definition in the context of RCW 39.26 and 39.80 should be done with DES after this legislative session.
