1. Questions and Answers:

- Due to the historic nature of the building, will there be any historic review of this project?
 - A1 Landmarks covers the exterior of the building and a portion of the 1st floor Lobby. Within this
 project, only items that impact the exterior aesthetics of the building would be subject to
 Landmarks approval. Windows or window treatments, such as coatings or blinds, would fall into
 this category.
- Will there be any other design review considerations for this project?
 - There are two property managers with interest in Pacific Tower. JLL will need to be involved in all review processes and provide approval on behalf of the building Owner. URG will want to be involved to provide comments on behalf of the Tenant.
- "In-Person Interview Considerations" are listed in the Notice to Consultants. Is there an option for a remote interview for a consultant team member who will be out of town during the interview period?
 - The selection panel will be meeting in-person to conduct interviews for short-listed firms. As stated in the Notice to Consultants, "Each top ranked firm must bring all necessary presentation equipment, materials and supplies (i.e. laptops, projectors, cables, easels, etc.) to fully support of their presentation."
