### 1. Questions and Answers

- a. Several questions were asked during informational meeting, however, the answers to these questions will be determined during the Pre-Design:
  - i. Age range of youth who will be housed in this facility.
  - ii. Level of community involvement with the facility.
  - iii. Level of restrictions within the facility.
  - iv. Length of stay by the youth at the facility.
- b. The intent is to conduct as many meetings and as much research as possible during August 2023 to help DSHS determine which existing location should be renovated or if a new facility will be built in order to allow DSHS to submit for design funding in the Supplementary Budget (due in early September 2023). It is understood that the amount of work completed by the end of August is not completely defined; but the intent is for the consultant to know that this project will be moving fast with a lot of tasks at the very beginning.



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c. The due date for the submittal has been revised (see revised schedule below). The intent is to still have the consultant's contract negotiated by the end of July.
