





### 23-25 FUNDING FOR EV AND EVSE

### 23-25 Transportation Budget (starting on page 9)

\$6M to install EVSE at facilities to accommodate charging station installation to support state agency fleets

### 23-25 Operating Budget (starting on page 137)

- \$1.72M to support ZEV staffing for LNI, DCYF, MIL, DSHS, DOC, and WSP
- ~\$2.6M for FY 24 & ~\$2.6M for FY 25 to install EVSE at facilities to accommodate charging station installation to support state agency fleets

### **FUNDING BREAKDOWN**



~\$11.2 M (between 23-25 Operating and Transportation budgets) to install EVSE at facilities to accommodate charging station installation to support state agency fleets



\$1.72M is to support ZEV staffing for DOC, DCFC, DSHS, LNI, WSP, and MIL




Up to 5% of funding will go to conduct electrical assessments of selected agency facilities

# UPCOMING EV PROJECT APPLICATION/PRIORITIZATION

Potential projects will be evaluated on criteria such as the following:

- How ready is the project to commence?
- Where is the project located and in what type of building?
- Could the project have its EV charging needs met by publicly available charging?
- What is the location's current and future charging demand?

Applications will be opened in August, with project selection and commencement in September.



### **TIMELINE**

#### **June-early July 2023**

DES/SEEP Develop EV project selection criteria and EV project application

#### September 2023

Review EV project applications

### **July 2023**

Distribute \$1.72M for ZEV staffing to DOC, LNI, DCYF, MIL, DSHS, and WSP

### August 2023

Release EV project application for state agencies to start submitting applications

### **September 2023**

Begin selected projects



### #1 help Save the planet!



#### • Low maintenance costs

Due to fewer moving parts and no need for oil changes, exhaust system repairs, or timing belt replacements.

#### No noise

In fact, electric vehicles are so quiet, they are now required by law to have an acoustic alert system (AVAS) to emit a sound when reversing or traveling below 12 mph.

#### Easy to drive

Better performance as EVs have more responsive acceleration and regenerative braking when easing off the accelerator.

#### Environment Friendly

Pure EVs have no tailpipe, so they don't emit any exhaust gases, which reduces local air pollution particularly in congested cities.

#### Better resale value

It worth remembering too the sale of new petrol and diesel vehicles will be banned from 2030 and sales of used vehicles with internal combustion vehicles will continue.

### **FUEL CHARGES**

### Fill up or Pay up

All gas-powered vehicles are required to be returned with a fuel tank of fuel.

If vehicle is not returned with a full tank of fuel, there will be a **\$20.00 charge** added to the cost of the reservation.

### EVs don't need to be "Topped off"!

You do not have to charge it up prior to returning. This is a great option for those who have a closer destination and want to try something new and fun.

Do your part and choose a more energy-efficient option.



### SHORT TERM RENTAL - WHY

### Why choose Fleet operations for your travel needs?

- The Fleet program strives to reduce costs to the taxpayers of Washington State.
- When choosing Fleet operations for travel we can help you with the right vehicle for your travels such as traveling over the mountains, across the state or carpooling together in town for a meeting.
- If you bring your vehicle to us for repairs or service, we can issue a loaner vehicle so that you will continue to be able to conduct state business.



### SHORT TERM RENTAL – WHERE

#### Where can you go to reserve a state vehicle?

Fleet operations HQ daily rental located at: 1312 Fones Rd, Bldg. 4 Olympia, WA 98501

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Reservations can be made by phone or in person 7:30 am - 4:30 pm Monday - Friday

Customers may rent/reserve compact and full-size sedans including hybrids, electric vehicles, 4x4 SUV (including hybrids) pick up trucks, ADA/ wheelchair accessible vans and 7-passenger minivans.

Invers locations are not staffed but reservations can be made 24/7 online at <a href="https://www.DES.wa.gov">www.DES.wa.gov</a>

INVERS vehicles can be picked up and dropped off 24 hours a day at these two locations:

Capitol campus daily rental - 1129 Washington St SE, Olympia, WA, 98501 Tumwater daily rental - 7510 New Market St SW Tumwater, WA 98501

### SHORT TERM RENTAL - WHEN

### When can you pick up your reserved state vehicle?



You can pick your vehicle up to 15 minutes prior to your reservation to 2 hours after your reservation start time. After 2 hours, your reservation is canceled. A 'no show' fee of \$30 will be charged to your agency if you haven't reach out to us by then.

Please take a close look at your reservation and check to see if all information is correct. Once your reservation time has started, you will not be able to shorten or cancel this reservation.

### PERSONNEL NUMBERS & FUEL CARD LOGIN

## Use the state personnel number or Employee ID number – not the agency number

You can contact your manager or your agency's HR to get your personnel or employee ID number, or you can find it on your paycheck.

Drivers need to be entered and active in the system to be able to use fuel pins.

### The WEX card is your ticket to fuel

Remember the WEX fuel card can only be used when you have a correct employee number.

The red DOT card is another fuel card tied to a specific vehicle. Use the last four numbers of the vehicle's license plate number.

### WEX CARDS ARE VEHICLE SPECIFIC



### One card per vehicle

- WEX cards are directly tied to the vehicle via license plate # and tracks when any type
  of fuel is purchased.
- Dispatch can provide real time help when card is not reading at the pump.

### One vehicle per card

- Fuel cards cannot be used for other vehicles, fill up gas cans for machines, etc.
- Fuel cards can only be used for the vehicle it is intended for.

### Need help? Get error message at pump? Call dispatch

 Call dispatch <u>before the third error attempt</u> during business hours for help in real time on why the card is not working: pump malfunction, operator error, or over daily limit.

### WINTER PREP

#### Remember to:

- Check for tire chains
- Check road conditions
- Have a plastic scraper
- Plan ahead, allow extra time
- Carry winter supplies

### WINDOW SCRAPING / DEFROSTING

- Please only use plastic ice scraper


## WHAT IS A REPLACEMENT?

## SUBMIT REQUEST FOR REPLACEMENTS



#### **DES Vehicle Purchase Requests**

- Change in class
- Addition to Fleet
- Not needed like for like

#### **SEEP exemption**

- Needed for any non EV request
- Separate from DES request
- Emption to be included with the DES Vehicle Purchase Request

## NEW VEHICLE = RETURN OF OLD VEHICLE

#### Replacements attached to previous plate

- Need previous plate back
- Can make internal trades before or after
- Let DES know of location assignment






