#### ABOUT PULLMAN REGIONAL HOSPITAL

- Located in Pullman and serves southeastern WA & northern Idaho
- Over 600 employees
- 24-hour emergency inpatient care facility
- Serve over 50,000 patients annually, generating over 130,000 annual visits
- Operating budget of over \$120M per year




#### Pullman Regional Overview

- Established in 1976, Public Hospital District No. 1-A, Whitman County (the "District") is located in the southeastern region of Whitman County, Washington (the "County")
- The District provides services to residents of the County, (including Washington State University) and Latah County, ID
  - District population is approximately 33,060 as of 2023
- The District owns and operates:
  - · Pullman Regional Hospital
    - Located in the City of Pullman, a 25-bed critical access hospital and Level IV state designated trauma center.
  - Pullman Regional Hospital Clinic Network, LLC
  - Palouse Specialty Physicians
    - A 45% owner in a joint venture with Gritman Medical Center and Whitman Hospital & Medical Center

- 24-hour emergency care facility
- Flow of patients/staff/operations throughout building throughout duration of project
- Operational excellence

## Involvement of the GC/CM is critical during the design phase:

- Phasing & coordination of systems and equipment
- Coordination to ensure patient satisfaction
- Real time cost estimating with input into products, installation methods and materials
- On-going value engineering & constructability

#### Project encompasses a complex or technical work environment

- 24/7 operational hospital
- Hospital operations and systems
- Safe, secure and clean facility
- Work not only around but within facility
