- 2. In your original application you identified a subcontractor outreach even on July 14th ahead of the application. How did the outreach go? Did it create interest in the EC/CM process?
  - a. The subcontractor outreach event originally planned for July 14th has not yet taken place due to adjustments in the overall project schedule. Schematic design efforts began just last week, prompting a realignment of outreach timing. In response, the District has adopted a coordinated outreach strategy across all GC/CM projects to streamline efforts and maximize subcontractor engagement throughout the program. This collaborative approach is intended to broaden subcontractor participation and avoid competition among contractors, ultimately benefiting the community.
