Named for American statesman Stephen A. Douglas, ardent supporter of U.S. westward expansion

Traditional home of Moses-Columbia, Wenatchi, Methow, Entiat, Chelan, Okanogan, San Poil and Nespelem American Indian people

Tucked into a magnificent curve of the great Columbia River, this county in the heart of the state is known as Big Bend Country. Sculpted canyons and coulees tell of the fiery lava flows and massive Ice Age floods that shaped the Columbia Plateau.
